



COVID-19 INFECTION-CONTROL FIELD REQUIREMENTS

WHAT WE KNOW

COVID-19 is here and, while there is still a lot yet to be learned about the illness, we know that:

- **It can spread person-to-person through respiratory secretions – especially coughs and sneezes.**
- **It spreads more easily through close contact.**
- **It can remain on surfaces and clothing for extended periods of time.**

PREVENTION IS KEY!

All persons working in the field must adhere to the following requirements:

- **KEEP YOUR DISTANCE:** Always maintain at least 6-feet of personal space.
- **WASH YOUR HANDS:** Wash with soap and water for at least 20 seconds each time.
- **IF SOAP AND WATER ARE NOT READILY AVAILABLE:** Use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- **SNEEZE AND COUGH INTO THE CROOK OF YOUR ARM OR INTO A TISSUE:** Throw the tissue away in the trash and wash your hands thoroughly.
- **AVOID TOUCHING YOUR EYES, NOSE AND MOUTH**
- **IF YOU FEEL ILL, STAY HOME:** If you have a cough, low-grade fever (99.14° F or more), chills, body aches, sore throat, or shortness of breath, **DO NOT COME TO WORK** and immediately contact your supervisor.
