CREATE A UNIFIED STAKEHOLDER VISION

Have a strong cohesive vision and rally a team of support and commitment from staff, students, and community members.

COLLABORATE

Ensure your school board and administration are on the same page from start to finish.

BE INFORMATIVE

Ensure your staff is informed early and often.



THE THREE Ps

Patience, perserverance, and persistence are critical.

COMMUNICATE Communicate early and often.

WHAT TO DO NEXT?

Start by asking the following questions:

- Does our district have a facility master plan? Is the board in full support?
- Do we have an updated facilties assessment of our buildings?
- Do our buildings meet our designated educational programmatic needs?
- Do we have a solid demographic study to determine future student projections?
- Have we engaged stakeholders to gain their thoughts and ideas for the future of our district?

IDENTIFY COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

- Outline any previous community partnerships the district has participated in.
- Within your long-range plan, identify which improvements could be implemented with the help of a community partner.
- Outline a communications plan to promote district meetings with potential partners.
- Facilitate dialogue between the district and the organization and find out where there is overlap between the entities.
